## **International Publications**

We are pleased to announce our recipients of the Research Excellence Award. Research Excellence Award introduced at SIHS to acknowledge individuals who accomplish remarkable research achievements. The Award aims to promote the research culture at SIHS. Below are the details of our three recipients:



Dr. Saira Elaine, Assistant Professor, Department of Medicine at SMDC, has published an article in the International Journal of Rheumatic Diseases. Her research titled 'APLAR recommendations on the practice of telemedicine in Rheumatology.' Telemedicine has been around for many years in developed countries. Before COVID-19 Pandemic, this consultation modality was in its infancy in developing countries. However, the pandemic changed the world entirely and led to the rapid and widespread adoption of telemedicine in rheumatology care.

For this reason, when the Asia Pacific League of Associations for Rheumatology (APLAR) working group was tasked with developing evidence-based recommendations for rheumatology practice, Dr. Saira volunteered for that. These recommendations guide the approach and use of telemedicine in rheumatology care to guide the highest possible standards of clinical care.



Ms. Nasim Rafiq (Ph.D. Scholar), Principal at SNC, has published an article in a renowned international journal - Frontiers in Public Health, section Digital Public Health. Her research title is "Whatsapp-Delivered Intervention For Continued Learning For Nurses In Pakistan During The COVID-19 Pandemic: Results Of A Randomized-Controlled Trial."

The research is conducted in the context of the current situation in Pakistan because nurses have critical roles and responsibilities during the COVID-19 pandemic. They continue to be at the front line of patient care in hospitals and are actively involved with evaluation and monitoring in the community. Therefore to enhance their extensive knowledge & skills, the study has been conducted in Shalamar Nursing College, Lahore.



**Ms. Madiha Mumtaz** (Ph.D. Scholar), Assistant Professor Biochemistry/Program Coordinator Medical Laboratory Technology at SSAHS, has published an article in the international journal of **Clinical Proteomics of Impact factor 3.98**.

She published her project after working meticulously for six months on **"Head and Neck Squamous Cell Carcinoma"** under renowned Prof. Dr. Connie R. Jimenez in international OncoProteomics Laboratory, VUmc-Cancer Center Amsterdam, Department of Oncology, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, and the University of Perugia Italy, where she got training on Gel Electrophoresis, Nanoscale liquid chromatography coupled to tandem mass spectrometry (nano LC-MS/MS) & Cell culture.


## **Updates**
