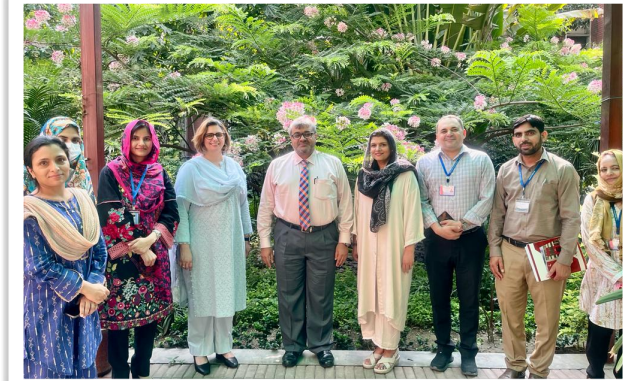

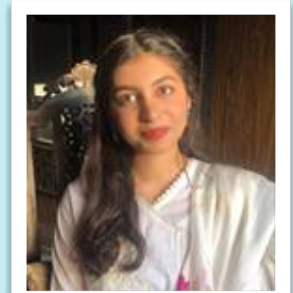


DHEP Admissions Open for 2024-25 Cohort

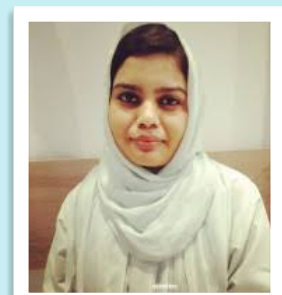

Annum Ishtiaq, DHEP'22, presented two papers at Australasian Association of Bioethics & Health Law Conference, held in Brisbane, Australia on 19-22nd Nov, 2023. Titles of Dr. Ishtiaq's papers: "*Changing Paradigms and Creating Opportunities - Establishing Clinical Ethics Forum and Consultations in Pakistan*" and "*Healthcare Ethics Literature in Pakistan: A Scoping Review of Thirteen Years*". Dr. Ishtiaq is a Family Physician and Palliative Care Physician at Liaquat National Hospital, Karachi and an Associate Faculty of DHEP.

Dr. Sarosh Saleem represented Pakistan at the Inaugural Asian Pediatric Ethics Conference [APEC 2023](#), 2-3 Oct 2023 in Singapore. Her talk in the conference was titled, "*Reclaiming Interests: Centering Children in Pakistan's Pediatric Ethics Discourse*". The conference was attended by Pediatric Ethicists from all over Asia as well as Australia and UK.
