Urology now boasts a Laparoscopic tower with 4k image resolution, enabling minimally invasive surgeries with exceptional clarity. Upgraded equipment also reached the Nephrology department, including new Dialysis machines and recliner chairs for increased patient comfort during treatment. Different inpatient departments will benefit from new high-tech patient monitors for closer monitoring of vital signs.

The Ophthalmology department received an Auto-refractor machine for faster and more accurate eye examinations. For the Private wing (P-I) and Cardiac ICU, upgraded ICU beds ensure enhanced patient care. The Gynecology theater is equipped with a state-of-the-art modular Anesthesia workstation for improved control during surgery. Medical-grade monitors were added to the Radiology department for clearer image analysis. The Gastroenterology department benefits from the addition of a Colonoscope and a Gastroscope, allowing for advanced endoscopic procedures.
