Ethics Training

As per the recommendations of HEC members, structured ethics training for interns and residents has been initiated. The Bioethics Department hosted two Physiotherapy house officers from 21st to 25th April, 2025 for a dedicated ethics training program. This marks the beginning of regular training sessions aimed at enhancing ethical awareness among healthcare professionals.

Ethics Grand Rounds

The Hospital Ethics Committee successfully organized two Ethics Grand Rounds.

12th Grand Ethics Round was held on 6th March 2025. The session focused on the Case of Brain Death and was presented by Ms. Samina Kouser and Mr. Adnan from the Nursing Department, with Dr. Shazia Rasul serving as the facilitator. The discussion provided valuable insights into the ethical challenges surrounding the diagnosis and management of brain death in clinical settings.

13th Grand Ethics Round took place on 29th April 2025. This session featured A Case of Acute Abdomen with Renal Failure, presented by Dr. Sarwat from the Medicine Department and facilitated by Dr. Shazia Rasul. Both sessions saw active participation and engagement from faculty, residents, and nursing staff.

PBG Meetings

The Bioethics Department regularly hosts Professional Bioethics Group (PBG) meetings every alternate month, providing a platform for in-depth discussions on critical issues in healthcare ethics and formulating recommendations for ethical improvement in clinical practice.

- The **24th PBG Meeting** was held on 3rd January 2025, featuring two engaging presentations: *The Use of Pig Organs for Human Transplants* by Amna Farooq and *A Case of Hypogonadism* presented by Dr. Hafeeza Naz.
- The 25th PBG Meeting followed on 7th March 2025, where Ms. Asfiya Aziz presented *The Last Word: Human Authorship in the Age of AI, exploring the ethical implications of AI-generated content in healthcare*. Second presentation was by Dr. Ameer Hamza's case discussion on *The Dangers of Arrogance, Ignorance, and Negligence*.
- The 26th PBG Meeting took place on 2nd May 2025, focusing on the topic Right to Conceive
 Women at a Disadvantage, presented by Dr. Jamshed Akhtar.

In May 2025, she was awarded her degree after successfully defending her dissertation with distinction! Her dissertation, "Between Guidelines and On-Ground Realities: Reimagining Clinical Ethics Consultation in Pakistan," explores ways to bridge the gap between formal ethical guidelines and the complex realities of clinical

practice in our local context.
